Session Description: For decades, critical care medicine has been rooted in automatic sedation and immobility for intubated patients on mechanical ventilation. In this presentation, we will dive deep a transformation of culture and practices in the ICU to create Awake and Walking ICUs. Physical therapists will be empowered to advocate for evidence based sedation and mobility practices.

- Physical therapists will be prepared to help their ICU teams shift perspective early mobility from "rehabilitation" to "prehabilitation".
